

Ozark High School Summer School Information

- June 3 – June 28 (Fit for Life dates June 3 – July 24 Monday – Thursday)
- Once you have requested your course in the Summer School Year, you can check back there under Course Schedule to see if you have been accepted into that course.
- You will be notified before summer school begins if the course you have enrolled in has enough to be offered. (Typically a minimum of 15 is required in order to offer the course)
- Students unable to finish a summer school class (or miss more than 5 days) will not receive a grade or credit.
- Lunch will be provided free for all students or students can bring their own lunch.
- All incoming 12th grade students must have the Meningitis A immunization **before** attending summer school. Please provide a copy of the immunization to the school nurse before summer school begins.

Fit for Life

- June 3 – July 24 (off week of July 1-4)
- Monday/Thursday 6:00am – 8:15am (0 Block) / 8:30am – 10:45am (1st Block)
- All Fit for Life students must have a current physical on file. Physicals completed during the 2018-19 school year are acceptable.

Drivers Education (Course Closed as of 4/23/19)

- Students must be 15 or older on June 4 to enroll
- The Driver's Education fee is \$100 to be paid on or before June 3. If your registration is confirmed, the \$100 fee will be added to your student's account in SIS and you will receive an e-mail by May 1 with payment instructions. The fee may be paid online or in person at the business office after the fee has posted to your account. Students who have not made the payment by June 3 will be dropped from the course. Payment will not be refunded if a student drops after the first day.
- Students will attend classes and have driving time (outside class time) determined at the first class meeting on June 3.

Online Courses

- Summer school Online Courses are available to incoming sophomore, junior, and seniors.
- Students may enroll in two online courses if they have successfully completed a previous online course with a C or higher. If this is the first time taking an online course, they may only take one online course.
- Failure of an online course will disqualify a student from being eligible to take any online courses the following semester.
- If a student fails an online course the previous Spring semester, the student is ineligible to take a Summer School Online course.
- If a student fails a Summer School Online course, the student is ineligible to take an online course the following Fall.
- Summer School Online Courses will take place over a seven week period, beginning the first day of Summer School.
- Students must submit a signed Summer School Online 'Hybrid' Education Agreement.
- Agreements may be obtained online (link underneath course offerings) or in the counseling center.
- Hybrid Meetings - Online students will be required to meet with their teacher(s) a minimum of three times during the summer school session.
- Scheduled time to be determined between the student and teacher.
- Meeting attendance will affect a student's grade in the course.
- Student's grade may necessitate additional meetings with the teacher.
