OHS ONLINE COURSES

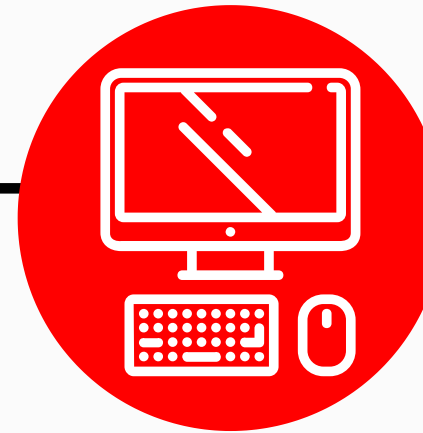
FACILITATED BY OZARK HIGH SCHOOL INSTRUCTORS

- Offers all required classes, including honors classes and many electives - [Course Offerings](#)
- Courses taught by Ozark teachers
- Tutoring/other interventions provided by OHS teachers
- Technology is provided by the District
- Calendar is the same as Ozark School District calendar
- Students can still participate in athletics and extracurricular activities that do not require a co-curricular class (i.e. band requires students to be enrolled in band class)
- Students remain eligible for the A+ scholarship

MOCAP

FACILITATED BY THE VENDOR YOU CHOOSE

- Full-time and part-time online learning opportunities are offered through the [Missouri Course Access and Virtual School Program](#), known as MOCAP
- School calendar (such as Spring Break) follows the vendor, not Ozark School District
- Technology is not provided by Ozark School District
- Students can still participate in athletics and extracurricular activities that do not require a co-curricular class (i.e. band requires students to be enrolled in band class)
- Students remain eligible for the A+ scholarship



Students are free to mix all offered courses – seated, OHS online, MOCAP, etc. – in any combination of classes, depending on what works best for their learning style.
