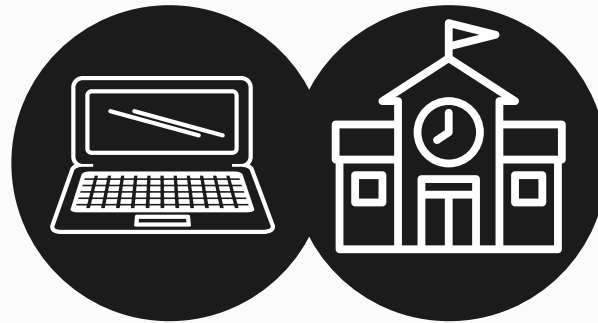
IN-PERSON LEARNING



STUDENTS LEARN SAFELY IN SCHOOL

- Traditional, at-school learning in the classroom
- Safety procedures are in place based on recommendations from state and federal resources.
- Students are strongly encouraged to wear masks if not vaccinated

HYBRID



STUDENTS LEARN SAFELY IN SCHOOL AND AWAY FROM SCHOOL

- Available for 6th - 12th grade students
- Students can mix and match in-person with online courses provided through OHS (for 10th-12th grade) or MOCAP (Missouri Course Access and Virtual School Program)

100% ONLINE LEARNING



STUDENTS LEARN SAFELY AWAY FROM SCHOOL

- Full-time online learning opportunities are offered through Ozark Virtual School! (OVS) for students in 1st - 6th grade
- Full-time online learning opportunities are offered through the Missouri Course Access and Virtual School Program, known as MOCAP, for K - 12th grade students; there are various vendors to choose from
- Students can still participate in athletics and extracurricular activities that do not require a co-curricular class (i.e., band requires students to be enrolled in band classes).
