HOW LONG DOES MY STUDENT HAVE TO STAY HOME?

10

If a student tests positive for COVID-19, they will be out of school for 10 days from the test date or the onset of symptoms.

This time frame is based on the number of days the student is considered contagious.

10

If a student is considered a close contact, they will be out of school for 10 days if they are unvaccinated or not masked.

This time frame is because symptoms may appear 2 to 10 days after exposure to the virus.

7

Students are able to return after 7 days with a negative test taken after day 5.
