HOW LONG DOES MY STUDENT HAVE TO QUARANTINE?

10

If a student tests positive for COVID-19, they will be out of school for 10 days from the test date or the onset of symptoms.

This time frame is based on the number of days the student is considered contagious.

14

If a student has had a high risk exposure (less than 6 foot for longer than 15 minutes), they will be out of school for 14 days.

This time frame is longer because symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure to the virus.

24

If a student has a family member in the same house who has tested positive, they will be out of school for 24 days.

10+14=24

This time frame is longer because the 14-day quarantine begins after the household member is no longer contagious (10 days).

These are the guidelines we are required to follow by the Christian County Health Department & CDC.
